Teachers Strike - Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023

As you may be aware the NEU Teaching Union have called its members to commence strike action on Thursday, 27^{th} April 2023 and Tuesday, 2^{nd} May, 2023.

At Glazebury CE Primary School we have a number of teachers in the union who will be exercising their right to strike, and as a result, our school will be partially open.
